Beaver Bus is a family owned local business, based in South Leicestershire. The Beaver Bus route picks up and collects students from Earl Shilton, Stoney Stanton and Sapcote - details of their pick up points can be found above. Students usually arrive on site by around 8:00am - 8:10am depending on traffic and number of pick ups.

Annual Tickets

Beaver Bus offer annual tickets only—no 'one way,' 'term,' or casual-use options are available. An Annual Ticket from any local Beaver Bus stop to The Hinckley School is £859, customers can qualify for an Early Bird Discount of £40 if they sign up before the advertised Beaver Bus Early Bird deadline. The discount is only eligible for payment plans starting in April, May and June as long as payments have been kept up to date.
