As you will have been aware, on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2023, The Hinckley School welcomed a team of five Ofsted inspectors for a full two-day inspection. I am delighted to inform you that the final Ofsted inspection report has now been released and a copy accompanies this covering letter. It is with great pleasure that I am able to announce that The Hinckley School has been awarded a 'Good' rating by Ofsted. Inspectors rated The Hinckley School as 'Good' in <u>all</u> areas: The Quality of Education, Behaviour and Attitudes, Personal Development, Leadership and Management and Sixth-form Provision.
